That's just what "*Sport A Shirt, Share A Night*" is! It is a great way for the staff at UNC Hospitals to raise money for the children and families of the Ronald McDonald House of Chapel Hill. All it takes is one willing person to act as "team coordinator." Coordinators simply ask fellow staff members to participate by making a \$10 donation to Ronald McDonald House in exchange for a "*Sport a Shirt, Share a Night*" t-shirt. The Coordinator is responsible for taking shirt orders, collecting payment, submitting completed order form to your local Ronald McDonald House, accepting delivery of shirts on April 21st, and distributing the shirts.

Why "*Sport a Shirt, Share a Night*?" Although it costs more than \$60 per family per night to operate the Ronald McDonald House of Chapel Hill, we ask each family to pay only \$10. But for some families, even \$10 is too much. This is an opportunity for members of our community to sponsor one family for one night at the Ronald McDonald House of Chapel Hill-by purchasing and "*sporting*" one \$10 t-shirt, each donor is "*sharing a night*" with a family in need.

The best part of this fundraiser is the benefit to those who need it most- the seriously ill and injured children who need their families close by while receiving treatment at UNC Hospitals. The mission of the Ronald McDonald House of Chapel Hill is to provide a "home away from home" environment that caters to the physical and emotional well-being of the entire family, offering support to families dealing with the trauma of having a child in the hospital.
